It was promoted in the Gatton Star and supported by various Facebook posts. The results of this consultation have been reported to management for consideration on how to improve visitors experience at the QTM.




Q1 Are you aware of the Queensland Transport Museum (QTM)?


Q2 Are you aware of the QTM Discount card?

Q3 When have you most recently visited the QTM?




