

Giant Chess and Checkers Set-up Instructions

EQUIPMENT

One (1) only Chess Set

- Two (2) large red duffle bags each containing 16 Chess Pieces
- One (1) Plastic Chess tarp
- One (1) Black Tarp
- Four (4) tent pegs

Hammer for tent pegs is optional and will need to be self-supplied.

One (1) only Checkers Set

- One (1) large red duffle bag
- Thirteen (13) Black Checkers pieces
- Thirteen (13) White Checkers pieces
- One (1) Plastic Chess Tarp
- Four (4) Tent Pegs
- Six (6) Plastic Joiners to make “kings”

WORKPLACE HEALTH AND SAFETY

Operators should assess and remain aware of likely risks in the set-up and operation of these equipment and are responsible to take all reasonable steps to ensure the safety of all operators, users and other people nearby.

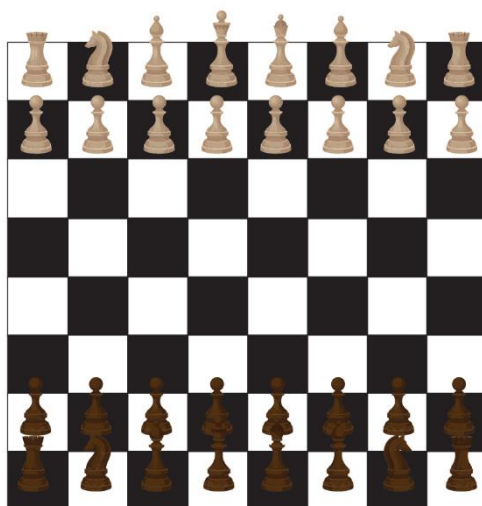
Key consideration includes but are not limited to:

- Trip Hazards
- Environmental Hazards including uneven or abrasive surfaces, solid objects, etc.
- Appropriate lifting techniques: it is strongly recommended that the large bags be lifted by a minimum of two people at all times.

It is the responsibility of the operator to ensure safety operations.

Set-up

- Select a location suitable for a 3m x 3m chess/checker board, *plus* 2m each side for a playing buffer.
- Check the proposed area for trip hazards, uneven or abrasive surface, sticks and stones, etc.
- Unzip the bag and roll out the chess/checkers board
- Tent peg the corners for the board before laying out the pieces. (Do not pull the tarp too tight as it will tear.)
- Remove the pieces from their bags and layout the chess and checkers set so that the white and black pieces are at separate ends of the board.
- In chess, the queen should start on the central square of the same colour (e.g. white queen on a white square.)



PACK-UP

- Pack-up in the reverse order of above
- Place the black chess pieces in one separate duffle bag and the white pieces in the other.
- Ensure all items are accounted for
- Return the equipment to Council where and when requested.

DAMAGES AND CLEANING

- Please report all damages to Council upon return of the equipment
- Please advise if the chess and checker sets require cleaning (e.g. If you had to pack it up in the rain and to needs airing and cleaning.)
- Council reserves the right to charge hirers for any unreasonable damage and cleaning.
